

This 20,000 s.f. project was built with the objective of providing an innovative, modern and appealing food court concept at a South Florida university. The result is a food court that breaks free from the traditional concept of an individual option lined up next to another individual option, without continuity or aesthetically appealing use of the space.

JWR Construction Services completed the construction on this project, with the space designed to allow diners to enjoy popular food concepts and experience the food court in its entirety without becoming fatigued. This was accomplished through the creation of intimate indoor seating areas, lively outdoor seating areas, complementary colors, flowing lines, varying planes and interesting sight lines. Each food concept respects trade dress and carries its own design features and characteristics, while remaining harmonious within the shared space.

This is achieved through the implementation of innovative materials including:

- Flooring – porcelatto and stained concrete
- Ceiling – hard ceiling, open ceiling, acoustical tile and clouds with different heights, patterns, colors and finishes
- Walls – treatments and tiles that define individual spaces while flowing from one concept to the next
